The Board of Elections and Registration held a special called meeting on May 29, 2018 for the purpose of certification of the May 22, 2018 General Primary.

PERSONS ATTENDING THE MEETING AND ROLL CALL:

Those present were, Chairman Tommy Allen, Vice Chairman Glenda King, Board Member Ruth Brown, Board Member Rose Harvey, Supervisor Olivia Morgan and Staff member Laura Bassett. Not present was Secretary Carla Freels.

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Allen called the meeting to order at 2:01 PM. Chairman Allen led the Invocation and the Pledge was recited. The meeting was properly advertised.

AGENDA APPROVAL:

The Agenda was presented, and it was approved as presented to the Board.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Supervisor Morgan gave a report on the numbers from the May 22, 2018 General Primary. There were 1099 absentee voters; 107 requested ballots by mail and 74 people returned their ballots. 4255 people voted at their polling place on Election Day. A total of 5354 people voted for the election which was 14.76% of active voters.

Currently the possible runoffs will be for Republican Governor, Republican Lieutenant Governor, Democrat State School Superintendent and the local District 1 School Board position.

- Board Member Harvey made a motion to change the board meeting time from 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM for all regularly scheduled meetings. Board Member Brown seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Motion passed.

BOARD OR STAFF CONCERNS:

Chairman Allen said that he may not be present for Election Day for the July 24, 2018 Run-off due to surgery.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

There was no Executive Session.

ADJOURNMENT:

No further business was required. Meeting was adjourned at 2:33 PM.
