RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-04

A RESOLUTION INITIATING VOTER REFERENDUM TO AUTHORIZE  
ISSUANCE OF LICENSES FOR THE PACKAGE SALE OF DISTILLED SPIRITS

WHEREAS the Georgia General Assembly's recent amendment of O.C.G.A. § 3-4-41(a) now allows a municipality's governing authority to initiate via resolution a voter referendum on the question of whether the issuance of licenses for the package sale of distilled spirits in the political subdivision shall be permitted or prohibited;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GUYTON, GEORGIA IN A REGULAR MEETING ASSEMBLED AND PURSUANT TO LAWFUL AUTHORITY THEREOF, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Initiation of Referendum. That a referendum election be initiated on the question of whether the issuance of licenses for the package sale of distilled spirits within the City of Guyton shall be permitted or prohibited.

2. Question Presented to Voters. As required by O.C.G.A. § 3-4-42, the referendum shall be conducted by presenting the following question to the City's qualified voters:

YES                      Shall the issuance of licenses for the package sale of distilled  
 NO                              spirits be approved?"

Those desiring to vote in favor of the issuance of the licenses shall vote "Yes." Those desiring to vote against the issuance of the licenses shall vote "No."

3. Referendum Election. In accordance with O.C.G.A. § 3-3-41(a) and (b), upon receipt and validation of this Resolution, the City of Guyton's Election Superintendent shall call and conduct a referendum election as provided for in Chapter 2 of Title 21, the "Georgia Election Code", and on a date authorized under O.C.G.A. § 21-2-540.





